Re: <u>Industry Comment to Proposed Rulemaking for the Standardbred Definition</u> of "Wire"

To Whom It May Concern:

On September 6, 2016, the New York State Gaming Commission submitted a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to the Department of State proposing an amendment to our standardbred rule defining the "wire," 9 NYCRR § 4100.1. The text of the proposed rulemaking can be found in the *State Register* on September 21, 2016.

This proposal involves a technical revision to the Commission's definition of the term "wire," which denotes the finish line of the race, in Standardbred racing rules. The proposed amendment uses a definition that is more flexible with regard to the location of the judges' stand.
