The Zweig night undercard featured a pair of \$60,200 New York Sire Stakes races for 3- year-old pacing fillies, with Roll With Joe fillies No Clouds Bluechip (\$13.20) and Dime a Dance (\$4.50) both proving narrowly victorious. No Clouds Bluechip vielded to 1-2 favorite Penpal (Pat Lachance) after a :56.3 half mile, maintaining a clear pocket trip through the far turn before vacating the pegs at the eighth Fotowon photo Bar Hopping outlasted the late surge of Milligan's School to take the \$300,000 Zweig Trot at Vernon Downs. pole and dueling to a half-length win in 1:51.3 via a :26.3 last guarter. Scott Zeron drove the daughter of Roll With Joe and B J's Sunshine for trainer John Berger. Dime a Dance rallied from farther off the pace in her event, sustaining strong uncovered gains on the far turn en route to a mid-stretch lead. Upon collaring Time On My Hands (Jason Bartlett), the daughter of Roll With Joe and Hat Dance Hanover was forced to stave off a late lunge from Angels Rockn Pink (Mark MacDonald), who split foes out of the pocket to just miss by a neck. Dime a Dance and driver Matt Kakaley prevailed in 1:53.3 for trainer Ron Burke. Live racing returns to Vernon Downs on Thursday (July 28) evening; first post is slated for 6:45 p.m. Eastern.
